Over the following pages we will provide a brief outline of the course subjects, expectations and identifiable career pathways from the course.

Vocational Education has several levels of study accreditation. Below I have listed these to assist in understanding what outcomes we are achieving with the Vocational Education and Training In Schools program (VETiS).

- AQF Level 1 – Certificate I

The purpose of the Certificate I qualification type is to qualify individuals with basic functional knowledge and skills to undertake work, further learning and community involvement. Certificate I qualifications are located at level 1 of the Australian Qualifications Framework. Certificate I qualifications must be designed and accredited to enable graduates to demonstrate the learning outcomes expressed as knowledge, skills and the application of knowledge and skills specified in the level 1 criteria and the Certificate I descriptor.

- AQF Level 2 – Certificate II

The purpose of the Certificate II qualification type is to qualify individuals to undertake mainly routine work and as a path way to further learning. Certificate II qualifications are located at level 2 of the Australian Qualifications Framework. Certificate II qualifications must be designed and accredited to enable graduates to demonstrate the learning outcomes expressed as knowledge, skills and the application of knowledge and skills Specified in the level 2 criteria and the Certificate II descriptor.

- AQF Level 3 – Certificate III

The purpose of the Certificate III qualification type is to qualify individuals who apply a broad range of knowledge and skills in varied contexts to undertake skilled work and as a pathway for further learning. Certificate III qualifications are located at level 3 of the Australian Qualifications Framework. Certificate III qualifications must be designed and accredited to enable graduates to demonstrate the learning outcomes expressed as knowledge, skills and the application of knowledge and skills specified in the level 3 criteria and the Certificate III descriptor.

What is VETiS?

A core element of the Queensland Government's Working Queensland jobs plan is ensuring Queenslanders have access to quality training programs that deliver effective skills to meet employment and business demands. Vocational Education and Training in Schools (VETiS) supports this aim by the delivery of nationally recognised qualifications to school students, providing them with the skills and knowledge required for specific industries.

VETiS funded by the VET Investment Budget

Department of Education and Training's VET investment budget funds those VETiS qualifications at the certificate I and II level which have been identified in consultation with industry, national skills shortages, Queensland Government priorities, and other evidence relating to effective training pathways that support employment.

Please note that some DTTC Certificate courses may have fees.

Other alternative courses:

From time to time, the opportunity for students to complete Course or Certificates arises at All Souls St Gabriels School. (e.g.: RSA and First Aid)
