SUBJECT CHANGE TIMELINES

For a subject change to be finalised, students or Parents / Carers Givers must make contact with the Academic Dean by the time and dates listed below. These timelines have been set to allow students to settle into classes for a full semester course without the disruption of excessive 'class swapping'. The impact upon eligibility for the Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE) in Years 11&12 is also a major contributor to this set of timelines.

Semester 1

Years 10 & 12 – 10.00am Wednesday Week 2 Term 1

Years 9 & 11 – 10.00am Wednesday Week 4 Term 1

(Note – Following Parent / Teacher Interviews at the beginning of Term 2, *only changes to levels of Mathematics* classes in Years 9 to 12 and *changes to levels of English* classes in Years 11 & 12 may take place by 10.00am Wednesday Week 1 Term 2. There will be no other changes made at the beginning of Term 2.)

Semester 2

Years 9 to 12 – 10.00am Wednesday Week 1 Term 3

(Note – *Only changes to levels of Mathematics* classes in Years 9 to 12 and *changes to levels of English* classes in Years 11 & 12 may take place by 10.00am Wednesday Week 1 Term 4. There will be no other changes made at the beginning of Term 4.)

Students new to the College may apply for exemption to these timelines through the Academic Dean. However, the general intent of the timelines will inform and guide decisions. In general terms, Week 4 of the new student's first term would be the deadline for any change.

YEARS 11&12 'STUDY LESSON'

Years 11&12 'Study Lesson' is only offered to students in the following categories:

- (1) Students undertaking one-day release Apprenticeship / Traineeship on-the-job training / employment. (The option of taking a full load of school subjects is still available.)
- (2) Overall Position (OP) eligible Year 12 students are able to apply for a 'Study Lesson'. The opinions of subject teachers and Head of House will be sought before the Academic Dean makes a recommendation to the Headmaster for the 'Study Lesson' to be granted or rejected.
