SUBJECT CHANGE TIMELINES

- Students in Years 7 & 8 follow a set curriculum. Students in Years 9 to 11 are able to consider the possibility of changing a subject during a meeting with the Academic Dean.
- For a subject change to be finalised, students or Parents / Carers must make contact with the Academic Dean by the time and dates listed below.
- These timelines have been set to allow students time to settle into classes for a full semester / senior unit without the disruption of excessive 'class swapping'.
- The impact upon eligibility for the Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE) and Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank (ATAR) in Years 11 & 12 is also a major contributor to this set of timelines.
