



Academic Colours

Open to students in Term 3 Year 12.

A candidate must meet the following criteria as at the end of Term 3 Year 12:

1. On "Headmaster's List" for two out of three Senior units.
2. All Year 11 and 12 subject results (on a 5 point scale) as A or B, with a majority of A.
3. Candidate to be enrolled in at least five QCAA General subjects. (In exceptional cases, refer to criterion 5.)
4. A 'credit' or higher standard of achievement in at least two academic school-entered competitions during Years 7 to 12; &/or other meritorious academic award/s or representation/s.
5. A candidate may be awarded Academic Colours for achievement in a non-ATAR eligible course, if s/he has achieved an outstanding meritorious award which, in the judgement of the Colours Committee and the Headmaster, deserves the highest recognition.
6. Major interruptions to the School's academic program (eg pandemic) resulting in the loss of opportunities to fulfil criterion 4, will be taken into account by the Colours Committee and the Headmaster.
